Sign In and Out

Each morning and afternoon, please sign your child in and out on the clipboard on the table outside the blue house. Please write a note on the Sign In sheet if your child is to be picked up by someone other than a parent. Without this written permission, we cannot legally release your child to anyone else. We appreciate you picking up your child at or before 12:30. Anyone picking their child up after 12:30 will be charged a \$1.00 per minute late fee.

Summer Camp Rhythm

Summer invites us to experience the joy of King Sun and all the water fairies! Our yard is a heaven for the children to explore, build, dream and play. Our daily rhythm will look something like this:

8:30-9:00 arrival

9:00 walk

9:30 - 10:30 Fairy snack, Ring time

10:30-11:30 Outside play, sprinkler, garden play

11:30-12:00 picnic lunch

12:00-12:30 Story time, juice popsicles

12:30 Departure

Illness or Home day

Please call the office if your child will be absent due to illness or other reasons. We would like to be able to pass on to other parents news of chicken pox or stomach flu, etc. Our policy is a child shouldn't come to school until they have been fever free for 24 hours.

Parking Thank you for your attention to safety
We are committed to limiting traffic around our school and neighborhood. Please carpool whenever possible. Otherwise, please park a block or so from the school and enjoy the short walk to school. If you need to park in front of the school, please:

- Drive very, very slowly
- Park only in front of school and school yard
- Do not make u-turns on 11th Street
- Watch for walking families

Things to Bring

- A simple lunch in a basket. Fingerfoods are best. Please remember we are a Nut Free school. Sun butter is a great alternative to peanut butter. Thank you
- A labeled water bottle each day.
- Children need a change of clothes (labeled) to keep in their extra clothes bag in their cubby.
- A pair of indoor slippers or slipper socks that are not too warm, that stay securely on their feet while they dance and play, and that have no cartoon characters on them.
- We are outside in our beautiful yard everyday. Please send your children with shoes and clothes that can get wet and sometimes muddy! (crocs are great) We are active workers in the sand!
- Sun hats (labeled) – we'll try to keep the hat on your child's head.
- Please apply sun screen on your child in the morning. We will reapply as needed but we count on you doing the first application.

Other important things to remember

Please be sure to check your child's cubby every day. Wet and sandy clothes are put in a grocery bag and hung on your child's hook. Please replenish their 'extra' clothes as needed. (Some children get very upset at the idea of wearing clothes that are not their own.) Pictures and projects on the top of cubbies are ready to come home.

Communication

It can be difficult for parents and teachers to talk during drop-off or pick-up times. If you have a concern or would like to meet with a teacher, a brief mention of it will work, and we will call you that afternoon or set up a time to get together.

Fruit Day

There will be a fruit salad day each week. Please bring a few pieces of fruit for us to chop that morning. We love peaches, melon, grapes, bananas, pineapple, etc . . . day TBA.
